IUPUI has a long history of community engagement through project-based courses, internships and practica, community-based research and consulting, and applied, practical, and translational work in Central Indiana. With the launch of the Solution Center in 2004, IUPUI created a community resource and outreach office specifically charged to:

- Serve the state as a key partner in its efforts to increase the number of highly trained and degreed professionals in Indiana.
- Facilitate meaningful collaboration and talent-driven partnerships with Indiana's businesses, nonprofit, and government sectors.

In this capacity, the Solution Center serves both the campus and external community by matching community needs and interests to the vast IUPUI network of highly trained and talented faculty, students, and researchers. Ideal engagements are those that increase mutually beneficial partnerships between the University's community of scholars and researchers, and business, industry, and government, and nonprofit organizations.

The Solution Center also serves the campus community by providing assistance to faculty to brainstorm and coordinate experiential learning ideas; link to internal and external partners and funding for community-based research; and identify community organizations for class projects, case studies, or other initiatives.
